Notice the Sent By email address. It appears to be legitimate. The 'sent by' address can easily be spoofed. Notice also that below, they request that you NOT reply to this message. Thus guiding you to the conclusion that you need to click on the provided link.

This is an actual link to FedEx.com ... very clever.

Notice the web link appears to be legit. However, if you hover your mouse pointer over the link WITHOUT CLICKING, you will notice the actual address appear.
