SANS' European ICS Security Summit brings together program managers, control systems engineers, IT security professionals and critical infrastructure protection specialists from asset owners and operators along with government and research leaders. The 2-day Summit provides delegates with an opportunity to learn and discuss the newest and most challenging cyber security risks to control systems and the most effective defences.

The Call For Papers is now open and potential speakers should send their proposed talks to the selection team asap. Talks should ideally contain case studies based on real-world experience, lessons learned, and best practices, and should give attendees actionable advice they can implement immediately upon returning to their organisations.

The event organisers are looking for timely talks that help illustrate the dramatic change in ICS cyber risks and/or provide repeatable examples/learning opportunities for how to address critical ICS challenges. The event audience spans across multiple industries and program committee members are looking for diversity in ICS applications (e.g. chemical, manufacturing, energy, building management, water, etc.)

- Sessions are generally 45 minutes.
