The 2017 Summit will be the 12th annual ICS Security Summit and located at Disney World, Florida.

The Summit will center on the theme “Defense: From the Inside Out.” In keeping with this theme, the presentations should focus on either defense “from the outside” or defense “from the inside” of the ICS. For example, the outside perspective could cover presentations looking at external events such as lessons learned from attacks this past year, information sharing, defense approaches for the larger community, and ICS Cyber Kill Chain Stage 1 type activities. Conversely, the “inside” perspective could cover presentations such as case studies at facilities, cyber informed engineering approaches, tested methodologies for detecting ICS abnormalities, and ICS Cyber Kill Chain 2 type activities.

Proposed presentations should be case studies based on real-world experience, lessons learned, and best practices, and should give attendees actionable advice they can implement immediately upon returning to their organizations.

The event audience spans multiple industries, and program committee members are looking for diversity in ICS applications (e.g. chemical, manufacturing, energy, building management, water, etc.)
